Vetta Wise

Moved to the Waveney Valley area from South Africa and has established herself here as a singer, choral conductor and singing teacher.

In South Africa she was greatly in demand as adviser and “trouble-shooter” to solo singers and choirs, also preparing them for competitions and acting as adjudicator and workshop leader in the main centres.

Her widely varied singing background as performer, choral director and opera chorus master: university singing teacher in both Opera and Drama (musicals) Department: and assisting the medical fraternity in correcting problems arising from faulty vocal technique, has given her a sympathy and love for the human voice with all its foibles and potential. She founded the Pakefield Singers, was Director of Music of Beccles Choral Society until her recent appointment at Saint Felix as head of Vocal Studies; and has recently founded the North Suffolk Youth Choir.

She runs singing days and performance training workshops for solo singers and for choirs, and is an area Music Leader for the “Sing Up” initiative

Valerie Walker

Is a singer with many years’ experience, both as a soloist and choral singer. During her time as a deputy head at a middle school she trained two very successful choirs, and helped with the training of the Suffolk Jubilee Choir; while teaching at a college of further education she ran singing classes for adults. She also founded the Lothingland Singers and Elizabethan Singers and was Musical Director for Beccles Choral Society. She currently sings with the Britten Pears Chamber Choir, the Blythburgh Singers and the Kettlebaston Festival Choir. In addition she performs with instrumental ensembles and teaches sight-singing and aural technique.

She has frequently worked with Vetta in singing workshops.
